

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Alternative 9B on the New Farms Development
at San Xavier)

RES. NO. 66-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council by Resolution No.
2 394-87 (Tabling San Xavier District Resolution 9-87-16
3 and 9-87-17) did direct the Water Resource Committee,
4 San Xavier District Council and their Consultants,
5 Tribal Attorney and Tribal Consultants to meet to
6 discuss and analyze Plan 6 and other alternatives; and

7 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Committee discussed and analyzed Plan
8 6 and other alternatives as directed; and

9 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Committee does recommend the 9B
10 Alternative which modifies the development plan, and
11 recommends that the Nation research the utilization of
12 unused water.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
14 Legislative Council does hereby approve the Water
15 Resource Committee's recommendation of the 9B
16 Alternative as attached and does authorize the Chairman
17 of the Nation or other appropriate Officers of the
18 Nation to direct the Nation's Consultants and the Water
19 Project Office Staff to revise the draft San Xavier
20 Development Plan accordingly.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
22 Council authorizes the Nation's Chairman or other
23 appropriate Officers to direct the Water Project Staff
24 to research the utilization of unused water under the
25 proposed Schuk Toak and San Xavier Farm Project as
26 provided under the Southern Arizona Water Rights
27 Settlement Act (SAWRSA).

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29 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
30 on the 31st. day of March 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum
31 was present with a vote of 1,100.0 for; 242.5 against; 297.5 not
32 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by Section 1 of Article XVI and Section 2 of Article XVII
of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the
Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
