

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support and Request Consideration of the Tohono O'odham Nation's
Application for Construction of New or Renovation of
the Existing Juvenile Detention and Rehabilitation Center)

2 WHEREAS, P.L. 99-570, the Omnibus Drug Enforcement, Education and
3 Control Act, Title IV, Subtitle C, cited as the Indian
4 Alcohol and Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act
5 of 1986, authorizes the construction or renovation of
6 new or existing Juvenile Detention and Rehabilitation
7 Centers for purposes of the Act; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has recognized
9 that alcohol and drug abuse among O'odham Youth is
10 severe and declared a war on alcoholism and drug abuse;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
13 approved a comprehensive plan designed to address the
14 problems of alcoholism and drug abuse cited as the
15 Tribal Action Plan; and

16 WHEREAS, the focus of the Tribal Action Plan is to provide a
17 continuum of care for alcoholics, drug abusers and their
18 families which is community based; and

19 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Judiciary, Juvenile Court Division,
20 is in the process of identifying and implementing
21 community-based, rehabilitative programs of treatment
22 and therapy for O'odham Youth; and

23 WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court is desirous of renovating the
24 existing facility or construction of a new facility
25 which will accommodate the multi-faceted rehabilitation
26 programs proposed to treat and rehabilitate O'odham
27 Youth with alcohol or drug abuse problems; and

28 WHEREAS, the existing Juvenile Detention facility is designed to
29 house youth offenders in a physically restrictive
30 setting with no options at alternative rehabilitation
31 services because of space limitations and building
32 logistics; and

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is soliciting applications
2 from Tribes for construction of new or renovation of
3 existing Juvenile Detention and Rehabilitation Centers
4 in accordance with the objectives of the Indian alcohol
5 and Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act, and,
6 the Tohono O'odham Judiciary is interested in making
7 such application for consideration; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is supportive of
9 this effort by the Tohono O'odham Judiciary and the
10 goals and objectives identified within the Tribal Action
11 Plan and approves the solicitation of funds to renovate
12 the existing juvenile facility or in the alternative to
13 construct a new facility which will accommodate and
14 facilitate the alternative rehabilitation programs
15 proposed by the Juvenile Court.

16 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
17 Council:

- 18 1. An application for Phase One of the Planning of New
19 Institutions (PONI), specifically for construction
20 for renovation of new or existing Juvenile Detention
21 Centers be submitted for consideration by the Bureau
22 of Indian Affairs; and
- 23 2. The Tohono O'odham Judiciary, Juvenile Court
24 Division is hereby authorized to coordinate the
25 activities required to effect the planning and
26 logistical events to comply with the Bureau of
27 Indian Affairs criteria and requirements including
28 carrying out the activities during Phase Two and
29 Three of the application process.
- 30 3. The Tohono O'odham Nation's officials will cooperate
31 and coordinate with the Tohono O'odham Judiciary in
32 all aspects of this project and are further
authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to
insure successful consideration and participation in
the PONI project.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th day of April, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,523.0 for; 117.0 against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b), (c), (2), (6), & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
