1	WHEREAS,	the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in
2		1982 replacing the Comprehensive Employment Training Act
3		(CETA); and

WHEREAS, funding is made available to state tribal and governments to establish programs for improving the $\mathbf{5}$ employment prospects of eligible persons through the 6 designation of service delivery area; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is entitled to JTPA funds to 8 develop a network of employment training programs 9 throughout the State; and 10

WHEREAS, the Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated 11 as service delivery areas and are eligible to receive 12 State JTPA funds; and 13

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation JTPA Program may apply for 14 State JTPA funds pursuant to Inter-Governmental 15 Agreement with the State of Arizona. 16

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative 17 Council that it hereby approves the agreement with the 18 State of Arizona, Department of Economic Security for 19 the delivery of JTPA Services on the Tohono O'Odham 20Reservation. 21

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council 22that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate $\mathbf{23}$ the program in the interim while negotiations are still 24 being conducted and no executed contract has been 25awarded by the Department of Economic Security. 26

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 27that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the 28Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate 29and execute this agreement and any amendments thereto 30 for the duration of the agreement, provided however, 31
