

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Women, Infant and Children Amendment)

RES. NO. 73-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Women, Infant and Children Program under an agreement
3 with the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona; and

4 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding of the agreement
5 shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono
6 O'Odham Legislative Council; and

7 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted by the Tohono O'Odham
8 Women, Infant and Children Program for review and
9 approval.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
11 Legislative Council does hereby approve the amendment to
12 the Tohono O'Odham Women, Infant and Children Agreement.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the
14 Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby
15 authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement and
16 any amendments thereto for the duration of the
17 agreement, provided however, that any amendments
18 affecting the funding or funding levels of the
19 agreement shall be submitted for further prior approval
20 by this Council.

21 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
22 on the 4th day of April, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum
23 was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
24 voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
25 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
26 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
27 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
28 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
29 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
30 984).
