(Adoption of the Domestic Affairs Committee's
Plan of Operation)

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is empowered to
2 prescribe the duties and powers of all Legislative
3 Committees; and

4 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee in coordination with the
5 Rules Committee have reviewed and discussed the
6 purposes, powers and duties of the Domestic Affairs
7 Committee; and

8 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Rules Committee do recommend
9 the adoption of this Plan of Operation; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed the
11 Plan of Operation and has incorporated the necessary
12 changes.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
14 Council that it hereby adopts the attached Plan of
15 Operation for the Domestic Affairs Committee under the
16 Legislative Branch.

18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
19 on the 5th day of April, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum
20 was present with a vote of 1,2490.0 for; 105.5 against; 285.5
21 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
22 Council by Section 1(b) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
