Plan of Operation)

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is empowered to
2 prescribe the duties and powers of all Legislative
3 Committees; and

4 WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee in coordination
5 with the Rules Committee have reviewed and discussed the
6 purposes, powers and duties of the Cultural Preservation
7 Committee; and

8 WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation and Rules Committee do
9 recommend the adoption of this Plan of Operation; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed the
11 Plan of Operation and has incorporated the necessary
12 changes.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
14 Council that it hereby adopts the attached Plan of
15 Operation for the Cultural Preservation Committee under
16 the Legislative Branch.



19 on the 5th day of April, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
20 was present with a vote of 1,534.5 for; 42.5 against; 63.0 not
21 voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
22 Council by Section 1(b) of Article VI of the Constitution of
23 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
24 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
26 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
27 984).
