LEGIS. ORDER NO. 86-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council reviewed the  
2 Judicial Services FY '88 Budget Modification #2; and

3 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee informed the Council that  
4 the budget presented has been adjusted from the one  
5 reviewed by the Committee; and

6 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee believes it should review  
7 the adjustments made by the Court Administrator before  
8 it comes back to the Council.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
10 Council that the Judicial Services FY '88 Budget  
11 Modification #2 be referred back to the Budget & Finance  
12 Committee for a final review of the adjustments made on  
13 the budget.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget be brought back during  
15 this Legislative Session.



23 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
24 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
25 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
26 Stat. 984).
