Department of Education, Office of Research and Improvement Library Programs for funding of the Venito Garcia Library and the extension libraries in Pisinemo and San Xavier; and WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding of the grant shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted by the Tohono O'Odham Education Department for review and approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the amendment to the Library Services grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the the Tohono O'Odham Nation Treasurer of hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant and any amendments thereto for the duration of the grant. provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th. day of April, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,496.5 for; 42.5 against; 101.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
