| 16 | WHEREAS, | it is necessary to provide a more responsive and effective |
| 17 | | legislative process, the Legislative Council has |
| 18 | | determined it to be necessary to consolidate the existing |

| 21 | NOW, THE | REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative |
| 22 | | Council, that it hereby consolidates the Legislative |
| 23 | | Committees as follows: |
| 24 | | 1. The Water Resources Committee, the Agriculture Committee and the Natural Resources Committee are |
| 25 | | hereby consolidated and shall be titled "Natural Resources Committee" which shall assume all |
| 26 | | jurisdictions and authorities of these Committees. |
| 27 | | 2. The Domestic Affairs Committee, and the Judiciary Committee are hereby consolidated and shall be titled |
| 28 | | "Judicial Committee" which shall assume all jurisdictions and authorities of these Committees. |
| 29 | | 3. The Human Resources Development Committee and the |
| 30 | | Health and Human Services Committee are hereby consolidated and shall be titled "Human Resources |
| 31 | | Committee" which shall assume all jurisdictions and authorities of these Committees. |
| 32 | | The Commerce Committee, and the Budget Finance Committee are hereby consolidated and shall be titled "Budget and Finance Committee" which shall assume all jurisdictions and authorities of these Committees. |

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the standing Committees of the Legis-1 lature shall consist of the Natural Resources 2 Committee, the Judicial Committee, the Human Resources 3 Committee, and the Budget and Finance Committee. 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Cultural Preservation and the 5 Housing Committee are hereby redesignated as Special

Committees of the Legislature.

IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby established an BE 8 Executive Committee of the Legislature, which shall 9 consist of the Chairman of the Legislative Council, 10 the Vice Chairman of the Legislative Council, all 11 Chairpersons of the four (4) Standing Committees and 12 the two (2) Special Committees; and shall assume all 13 jurisdiction and authorities previously delegated to 14 the Rules Committee of the Legislature; and shall 15 further include but not be limited to: budgetary 16 oversight on the all budgets administered by the 17 legislative branch, development of internal committee 18 policies, reviewing and providing recommendations on 19 all emergency items proposed for legislative action, 20prioritize and approve training/workshops for members 21 of the Legislative Council, and any other authority 22 or task delegated by the Legislative Council. 23

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson 24 of the Legislative Council shall serve as Chairperson 25and Vice Chairperson of the Executive Committee of the 26 Legislature, and shall also serve as ex-officio 27 members of all legislative committees. 28

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following provisions shall govern 29the membership requirements and sessions of the 30 Legislative Committee: 31

With the exception of the Executive Committee of the 1. Legislature, committee membership shall be limited to

NO. 04-90 (Consolidation of Legislative Committees; Establishing Requirements) Page Three (3) 5 members and shall consist of primary representatives 1 of the Legislative Council, subject to the expressed restrictions contained in this resolution. 2 All Legislative Representatives elected to serve on 2. 3 the Budget and Finance Committee shall not be eligible to serve on any other Legislative Committee. 4 All Legislative Representatives elected to serve as 3. 5 the Chairperson of a Standing Committee of the Legislature shall not be eligible to serve on any 6 other Legislative Committee. 7 The first four days of the Week, Monday through Thursday, shall be reserved for Standing Committee 4. 8 meetings, Fridays shall be reserved for Special meetings, special sessions of the committee 9 legislature, and meetings of the Executive Committee of the Legislature. 10 IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Committee of the BE 11 Legislature is hereby authorized to amend the 12 Legislative Rules to comply with the provisions of 13 this Resolution. 14 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the provisions of this resolution 15 shall effective immediately, upon passage by the 16 Nation's Legislature and upon enactment, by the 17 signature of approval, by the Chairman of the Nation. 18 The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham 19 Council on the <u>8th</u>. day of <u>January</u>, <u>1990</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>378.0</u> for; <u>1,104.5</u> against; <u>241.5</u> not voting; and <u>02</u> absent, failed to pass because it did not 20 receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2 of 21 Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation. 22 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 23 24 Edward D.
