

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Sanitation Facility Deficiencies)

RES. NO. 07-90

1 WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, Office of Environmental Health
2 (OEH), conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities
3 Deficiencies, annually; and

4 WHEREAS, the OEH assessment does have an impact upon
5 Congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of
6 funds; and

7 WHEREAS, the IHS has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the
8 four (4) most desirable projects and does allocate
9 points impacting upon overall prioritization of
10 projects; and


11 WHEREAS, OEH has provided recommendations, to the Tohono O'Odham
12 Nation, regarding the most critical need.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation has
14 determined that the following deficiencies are the four
15 most critical and desirable, in descending order of
16 prioritization:

- 17 1. Pisinemo (Water, Phase I)
- 18 2. Sells (Sewer Lagoon)
- 19 3. Topawa (Water & Sewer)
- 20 4. Hickiwan (Water & Sewer)

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
22 on the 8th. day of January, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
23 was present with a vote of 1,527.0 for; 57.0 against; 140.0
24 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
25 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
