- WHEREAS, the IHS has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4) most desirable projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall prioritization of projects; and
- WHEREAS, OEH has provided recommendations, to the Tohono O'Odham Nation, regarding the most critical need.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation has determined that the following deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order of prioritization:
 - 1. Pisinemo (Water, Phase I)
 - 2. Sells (Sewer Lagoon)
 - 3. Topawa (Water & Sewer)
 - 4. Hickiwan (Water & Sewer)

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th. day of <u>January</u>, <u>1990</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,527.0</u> for; <u>57.0</u> against; <u>140.0</u> not voting; and <u>03</u> absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant

Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
