


RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Memorandum of Agreement between Arizona Department of Economic  
Security and the Tohono O'odham Nation)


1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Job  
2 Opportunities Basic Skills (JOBS) Program funded by the  
3 Department of Health and Human Services, Family Support  
4 Administration (DHHS/FSA); and  
5 WHEREAS, the JTPA/JOBS Personnel has established a working  
6 relationship with the Arizona Department of Economic  
7 Security (ADES) in the determination of the Tohono O'odham  
8 Nation's total AFDC adult population residing on the  
9 reservation, and in the determination of the designated  
10 service area per the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
11 Resolution No. 367-89; and  
12 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Family  
13 Support Administration (DHHS/FSA) requires that a formal  
14 agreement be developed and established between the Arizona  
15 Department of Economic Security (ADES) and the Nation in  
16 regards to the working relationship between the two  
17 entities; and  
18 WHEREAS, the JTPA/JOBS Program has submitted for review and final  
19 approval the attached Memorandum of Agreement between the  
20 Arizona Department of Economic Security and the Tohono  
21 O'odham Nation.  
22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
23 Council does hereby approve the Memorandum of Agreement  
24 between the Arizona Department of Economic Security and  
25 the Tohono O'odham Nation.  
26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
27 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
28 Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are  
29 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement,  
30 provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
31 agreement shall be submitted for further prior approval  
32 by this Council.

1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
2 on the 3rd day of April, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
3 present with a vote of 1,607.0 for; 117.0 against; -0- not  
4 voting; 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
5 by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
6 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
7 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
8 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
9 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).



24 submittal.


