WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Job Opportunities Basic Skills (JOBS) Program funded by the Department of Health and Human Services, Family Support Administration (DHHS/FSA); and

- WHEREAS, the JTPA/JOBS Personnel has established a working relationship with the Arizona Department of Economic Security (ADES) in the determination of the Tohono O'odham Nation's total AFDC adult population residing on the reservation, and in the determination of the designated service area per the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 367-89; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Family Support Administration (DDHS/FSA) requires that a formal agreement be developed and established between the Arizona Department of Economic Security (ADES) and the Nation in regards to the working relationship between the two entities; and
- WHEREAS, the JTPA/JOBS Program has submitted for review and final approval the attached Memorandum of Agreement between the Arizona Department of Economic Security and the Tohono O'odham Nation.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the Memorandum of Agreement between the Arizona Department of Economic Security and the Tohono O'odham Nation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement, provided however, that any amendments affecting the agreement shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
