

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(EARN Workfare Demonstration Project)

RES. NO. 106-90

- 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve, by
2 Resolution No. 298-87, the application of the Tohono
3 O'odham Social Services for a three year Workfare
4 Demonstration Project to develop and implement the EARN
5 Demonstration Program; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did enter into a Cooperative
7 Agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs on September
8 20, 1988, to develop and implement the EARN Workfare
9 Demonstration Project; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the purpose of the EARN Demonstration Project is to foster
11 economic independence and self-sufficiency in individuals
12 and families; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 298-87 indicated a period of October 01,
14 1987 through September 30, 1990; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the Agreement was not awarded until September 20, 1988;
16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the need for the EARN
18 Demonstration Project, to continue its mission of
19 fostering economic independence and self-sufficiency in
20 individuals and families; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to extend the
22 agreement for the provision of services during FY 1991;
23 and
- 24 WHEREAS, any amendment affect the funding or funding levels of the
25 Agreement requires the review and approval of the
26 Legislative Council; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
28 approved the EARN Demonstration Project Grant No.
29 H50G14208848; and
- 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
31 Council that it does hereby approve the request to the
32 Bureau of Indian Affairs for a one year extension of the
EARN Demonstration Project.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of the extension shall be for
2 the period of September 30, 1990 through September 30,
3 1991.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
5 hereby approves the attached budget for the EARN
6 Demonstration Project.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
8 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
9 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
10 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
11 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
12 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted
13 for further prior approval by this Council.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
15 on the 3rd day of April, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
16 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
17 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
18 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
19 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
20 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
21 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
22 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




