

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Archaeological Mitigation Guidelines and Budget for the
San Xavier Cooperative Rehabilitation)

RES. NO. 107-90

- 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council convened in a
2 meeting on April 02, 1990 and approved the mitigation
3 guidelines and budget for archaeological mitigation for
4 San Xavier Cooperative Rehabilitation; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Tohono O'odham Nation's
6 Archaeological Protection Ordinance (No. 06-84), human
7 remains will not be available for study; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a limited number of artifacts, excluding burials, will be
9 photographed; and
- 10 WHEREAS, artifacts that are not associated with burials and that
11 will be allowed to be studied are included on the list,
12 "Artifacts To Be Studied" attached hereto and made a part
13 hereof; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative and San Xavier District
15 Council realize that a very small percentage of the
16 artifacts will need to be studied by specialized personnel
17 and equipment that is not available within the Tohono
18 O'odham Nation; and
- 19 WHEREAS, a list, "Artifacts To Be Studied off Reservation" is
20 attached hereto and made a part hereof; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council wishes that the curation
22 of artifacts recovered from the San Xavier Farm
23 Rehabilitation Project be at one location within the
24 Tohono O'odham Nation; however, the District recognizes
25 the need for the proper storage and handling of artifacts
26 and will allow the temporary storage of artifacts at the
27 National Park curation facility and strongly recommends
28 the final storage facilities of said artifacts be within
29 the San Xavier District; and
- 30 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council passed supporting Resolu-
31 tion No. 04-89-06 for the mitigation guidelines; and
- 32 WHEREAS, the mitigation work will be divided into two phases, and
the budget for Phase I is attached hereto, and made a part
hereof; and

1 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council passed a Resolution (Res.
2 07-89-05) approving the Phase I budget.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
4 Council approves the guidelines set forth in this
5 resolution for archaeological mitigation for the San
6 Xavier Cooperative Rehabilitation.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
8 does hereby approve the Phase I budget of \$184,804.00.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
10 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
11 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
12 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
13 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
14 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
15 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
17 on the 3rd day of April, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
18 present with a vote of 1,610.0 for; 114.0 against; -0- not voting;
19 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
20 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
22 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
23 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
