

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Recess Meeting - Reconvene April 6, 1990)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 112-90

1 WHEREAS, the agenda for the April 5, 1990, Tohono O'odham  
2 Legislative Council meeting was reviewed; and

3 WHEREAS, the Alcoholism Budgets were pending Committee review  
4 following corrections made in preliminary review; and

5 WHEREAS, the TSDA/JTPA Two (2) Year Job Training Plan was due by  
6 the State on April 12, 1990; and

7 WHEREAS, the Alcoholism, RAPA, and Training Budgets were added to  
8 the running agenda by Legislative Order No. 87-90; and

9 WHEREAS, the TSDA/JTPA Job Training Plan was not included on the  
10 running agenda; and

11 WHEREAS, requests were made to address the above-mentioned item  
12 during this General Session.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
14 Council that it hereby recesses in order to allow the  
15 appropriate oversight committees to review the remaining  
16 items on the running agenda, including the TSDA/JTPA Job  
17 Training Plan (JTP).

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
19 that it will reconvene Friday, April 6, 1990 to conclude  
20 the running agenda for the April General Session.


21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Legislative Committee completed reports  
22 be presented to the Council as well.

23 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham  
24 Council on the 5th day of April, 1990 at a meeting at which a  
25 quorum was present with a vote of 1,175.0 for; -0- against; 549.0  
26 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
27 Council by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the  
28 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
29 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
30 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
31 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
