

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Pre-Application for EPA Grant Indian Set Aside Funds
for Funding Cycle 2 - 1990)

RES. NO. 125-90

1 WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has set aside
2 funds, under an amendment to the 1987 Clean Water Act to
3 help pay for planning, design and building of wastewater
4 treatment systems to serve Indian Tribes and Alaska Native
5 Peoples; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has critical unmet needs, in the
7 area of wastewater treatment systems, projected to cost
8 several millions of dollars; and

9 WHEREAS, projects which would address this unmet need are prime
10 candidates for funding under the EPA Indian set aside
11 grant program; and

12 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service, Office of Environmental Health,
13 in concert with the Nation's Research and Planning
14 Department has conducted an engineering analysis of
15 proposed projects which represent the most critical need
16 of the Nation and which have the highest potential for
17 success, under EPA guidelines; and

18 WHEREAS, those needs identified, by this process, and their
19 priority ranking are:

- 20 1. Sells Lagoon Rehabilitation & Expansion
- 21 2. Scattered Projects (Septic Tank/Leach Field)
- 22 3. Chui Chu Collection and Treatment System
- 23 4. Santa Rosa Village Community Treatment Facility
- 24 5. Pisinemo Community Treatment Facility
- 25 6. Queen's Well Community Collection and Treatment Facility

26 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did submit the priority listing,
27 above, to EPA, for consideration, in 1989; and

28 WHEREAS, the EPA has selected the Sells Lagoon project, for
29 consideration for funding, in the 1989 funding cycle; and

30 WHEREAS, the EPA has determined that the Nation's application for
31 the Sells Lagoon Project is eligible for approval and has
32 reserved funds under the Indian Set Aside provisions of
Section 518(c) of the Water Quality Act Amendments of
1987; and

1 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has reserved funds to be
2 contributed towards this project; and

3 WHEREAS, the EPA will utilize the priority listing, submitted for
4 1989, unless the Nation submits an amendment thereto; and

5 WHEREAS, based upon the potential for successful award of the Sells
6 Lagoon, it is in the best interests of the Nation, to
7 amend the project priority listing.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
9 Council does hereby approve and authorize the submission
10 of funding cycle 2 (1990) pre-applications to the EPA, for
11 wastewater projects.


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the project priority listing is hereby
13 amended, for the 1990 application period, to the
14 following:

- 15 1. Sil Nakya Wastewater Project
- 16 2. Scattered Projects (Septic Tank/Leach Fields)
- 17 3. Chui Chu Community Collection and Treatment
18 Systems
- 19 4. Santa Rosa Village Community Treatment Facility
- 20 5. Pisinemo Community Treatment Facility
- 21 6. Queen's Well Community Collection and Treatment
22 Facility

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
24 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
25 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
26 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant.

27 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
28 on the 24th day of April, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
29 present with a vote of 1,422.0 for; 79.0 against; 57.0 not voting;
30 166.0 (04) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
31 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
32 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
