

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Requesting the Investigation of the Shooting Death
of Tyrone Childs)

RES. NO. 126-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has authority to take actions
2 necessary for the safety, health, and general welfare of
3 its members; and
4 WHEREAS, Tyrone Childs was an enrolled member of the Tohono O'odham
5 Nation; and
6 WHEREAS, Tyrone Childs was shot and killed by Pima County Deputy
7 Sheriff Mark Penner on April 1, 1990; and
8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby expresses its extreme
9 concerns on the questionable shooting of its fellow
10 member, Tyrone Childs, and gives its utmost condolence to
11 the family of Tyrone Childs.
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation is
13 hereby requesting that an immediate and thorough
14 independent investigation be conducted by the office of
15 the United States Attorney General on the shooting death
16 of Tyrone Childs.
17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said independent investigation shall
18 include, but not be limited to, the actions, structure,
19 and procedures of the Ajo Sub-Station, Pima County
20 Sheriff's Office for any civil rights violations.
21 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby
22 requests Representative Morris K. Udall of the United
23 States Congress, Senator John McCain and Senator Dennis
24 DeConcini of the United States Senate, and Senator Daniel
25 Inoyue, Chairman of Senate Select Committee on Indian
26 Affairs to take all actions necessary to ensure a thorough
27 and complete investigation on the shooting death of Tyrone
28 Childs and that such agencies consult with the Tohono
29 O'odham Nation as to the scope and conduct of such
30 investigations.


1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council

3 present with a vote of 1,558.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
4 166.0 (04) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
5 Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
7 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
8 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
9 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




