

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointment by Acclamation of Lenora Montana to
Legislative Committees)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 137-90

1 WHEREAS, Article XII, Section 3.F.1. of the Legislative Rules
2 states: "In the event that the number of candidates are
3 equal to or less than the number of vacancies existing,
4 the Legislative Chairperson may request a motion and
5 second from the floor to appoint all the candidates to the
6 vacant positions."; and

7 WHEREAS, vacancies were created due to the resignation of
8 Councilman Henry Ramon, specifically in the Cultural
9 Preservation Committee (1), the Human Resources
10 Development Committee (1), and the Natural Resources
11 Committee (1); and

12 WHEREAS, only one candidate, Councilwoman Lenora Montana, currently
13 qualifies to fill the three vacant positions.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
15 Council that it hereby appoints, Councilwoman Lenora
16 Montana to the Cultural Preservation Committee, the Human
17 Resources Development Committee, and the Natural Resources
18 Committee, by acclamation, pursuant to Article XII,
19 Section 3.F.1. of the Legislative Rules.

20 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the
21 7th. day of May, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
22 with a vote of 1,661.5 for; -0- against; 62.5 not voting; 04
23 (a)(b) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1
24 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
25 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
26 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
27 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
28 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
