

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Adoption of the Legislative Calendar  
June 01, 1990 - May 31, 1991)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 138-90

1 WHEREAS, the Policies and Procedures of the Legislative Council  
2 states in Article I, Section 1.A LEGISLATIVE CALENDAR, Sub  
3 sections 1 and 3:

4 1. Prior to an official adjournment, the Legislative  
5 Council shall adopt a Legislative Calendar which shall  
6 commence on the first working day of June on which the  
7 Legislative Council will be called into legislative  
8 session. The Calendar shall specify dates for the  
9 general sessions, recess periods, recognized holidays  
10 and the days of adjournment.

11 3. The Legislative Calendar shall be based only on  
12 working days and scheduled paid holidays; and

13 WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has prepared a Legislative Calendar  
14 in accordance with the Policies and Procedures of the  
15 Legislative Council.


16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does  
17 hereby adopt the Legislative Council Calendar which  
18 commences on June 01, 1990 and ends on May 31, 1991.

19 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the  
20 7th day of May, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present  
21 with a vote of 957.5 for; 766.5 against; -0- not voting; 04 absent,  
22 pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of  
23 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,  
24 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and  
25 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
26 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
27 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
