

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amendment to Section 1.E. PUBLIC HEARINGS of the Policies
and Procedures of the Legislative Council)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 143-90

1 WHEREAS, the Rules Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2 Council has been reviewing the Policies and Procedures
3 of the Legislative Council; and

4 WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has been reviewing the minutes of the
5 Public Hearings which were held this past year; and

6 WHEREAS, the transcribing and the review of these minutes have
7 taken some time for processing, the Rules Committee is
8 making the following amendments to Section 1.E. PUBLIC
9 HEARINGS, p. 2 of the Policies and Procedures of the
10 Legislative Council:

- 11 1. During the first General Session of the Legislature,
12 following the election, the Legislature shall
13 schedule and conduct public hearings to get input
14 from the membership to set goals and objectives for
15 the Tohono O'Odham Nation, and to report to the
16 membership the status of the previous goals and
17 objectives.
- 18 2. The Public Hearings shall be scheduled every election
19 year.
- 20 3. The Public Hearings shall be scheduled to cover the
21 four directions, North, South, East, West and shall
22 be rotated among the Districts every election year.
A final Public Hearing shall be scheduled in Sells.
- 23 4. The minutes of the Public Hearings shall be presented
24 to the Legislature for review and action in their
25 respective Legislative Committees.
- 26 5. The Legislative Committees may hold public hearings
27 to obtain public input regarding their specific
28 responsibilities and areas of jurisdiction.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does
30 hereby amend Section 1.E. PUBLIC HEARINGS, p. 2 of the
31 Policies and Procedures of the Legislative Council to
32 read as follows:

- 33 1. During the first General Session of the Legislature,
34 following the election, the Legislature shall
35 schedule and conduct public hearings to get input
36 from the membership to set goals and objectives for
37 the Tohono O'Odham Nation, and to report to the
38 membership the status of the previous goals and
39 objectives.
- 40 2. The Public Hearings shall be scheduled every election

3. The Public Hearings shall be scheduled to cover the four directions, North, South, East, West and shall be rotated among the Districts every election year. A final Public Hearing shall be scheduled in Sells.
4. The minutes of the Public Hearings shall be presented to the Legislature for review and action in their respective Legislative Committees.
5. The Legislative Committees may hold public hearings to obtain public input regarding their specific responsibilities and areas of jurisdiction.

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th. day of May, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,554.5 for; 63.5 against; -0- not voting; absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
