2 Education Department with tribal funds; and


3 WHEREAS, amendments affecting the funding level or change in the  
4 purpose for which the funds were budgeted are required to  
5 be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham  
6 Legislative Council; and

7 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
9 Council that it hereby approves that amendment  
10 transferring funds between line items, and authorizes  
11 expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.


12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council

14 present with a vote of 1,485.0 for; 114.0 against; 125.0 not  
15 voting; 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
16 Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




