Identify new provisions of law needed in Congress, (2) in the Legislative Council, and in the Arizona Legislature to implement a water recharge program, consistent with principles, benefits, obligations of the 1982 Settlement Act. of the Bureau the assistance of (3) Request Reclamation and other interested parties to undertake a thorough assessment of a recharge while insuring that the federal obligation to construct a new water project at the San Xavier District is not waived. Recommend actions to the Legislative Council needed to implement a recharge program for the San Xavier District using 9B water, if such a program proves desirable; and WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee did bring on a consultant to initiate and pursue the study tasks needed, to explore the technical feasibility of a recharge program, in lieu of allocating the waters for delivery to the 9B new farm as authorized in recommendation No. 1; and WHEREAS, the consultant did make presentations to the Water Resources Committee and the San Xavier District; and WHEREAS, additional time is needed by the consultant to summarize and finalize data which is still being received; and WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee is recommending an extension of two (2) months to make its final recommendation, and that said recommendation will be brought forth as soon as possible within that two (2) month period. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the Water Resources
