

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(JTPA Federal Grant in the amount of \$539,279.00)

RES. NO. 156-90

1 WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in
2 1982 replacing the Comprehensive Employment Training Act
3 (CETA); and

4 WHEREAS, funding is made available to state and tribal government
5 prospects of eligible persons through the designation of
6 service delivery area; and

7 WHEREAS, the Nation is entitled to JTPA funds to develop a network
8 of employment training programs throughout the Nation; and

9 WHEREAS, the Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated
10 as service delivery areas and are eligible to receive
11 Federal JTPA funds; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation JTPA Program may apply for
13 Federal JTPA funds pursuant to the Agreement with the
14 Department of Labor.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
16 Council that it hereby approves the grant with the
17 Department of Labor for the delivery of JTPA Services on
18 the Tohono O'Odham Reservation in the amount of
19 \$539,279.00 beginning July 1, 1990 and ending June 30,
20 1991.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
22 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
23 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
24 being conducted and no executed grant has been awarded by
25 the Department of Labor.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
27 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the
28 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
29 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this grant,
30 and any amendments thereto for the duration of the grant,
31 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
32 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted
for further prior approval by this Council.

1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
2 on the 11th. day of May, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
3 present with a vote of 1,599.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
4 125.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
5 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
7 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
8 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
9 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
