1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently operating the
2 Mining Department with tribal funds; and


3 WHEREAS, amendments affecting the funding level or change in the
4 purpose for which the funds were budgeted are required to
5 be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham
6 Legislative Council; and

7 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
9 Council that it hereby approves this amendment to increase
10 that amount by \$5,046.00, and authorizes expenditures in
11 accordance with the attached budget.

12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
13 on the 4th day of June, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
14 present with a vote of 1,318.0 for; 406.0 against; -0- not voting;
15 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
16 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
17 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
18 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
19 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
20 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


