

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Prevention Education - T.O.Y.S. United Way Grant  
Budget Modification #1)

RES. NO. 178-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the  
2 Prevention Education Services under an agreement with  
3 United Way of Tucson; and

4 WHEREAS, presentation of the Prevention Education Program was held  
5 on May 15, 1990 to the United Way Board of Directors; and

6 WHEREAS, the Nation was informed that the allocation for funding  
7 for FY 1990-91 is \$9,333.00; and

8 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of  
9 the agreement shall be submitted for review and approval  
10 by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and


11 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval  
12 by the Tohono O'odham Youth Services/Prevention Education  
13 Program.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
15 Council does hereby approve this amendment and authorize  
16 expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
18 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
19 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are  
20 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement,  
21 provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
22 funding or funding levels of the agreement shall be  
23 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

24 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
25 on the 5th day of June, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
26 present with a vote of 1,423.5 for; -0- against; 300.5 not  
27 voting; 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
28 by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
