

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Proposed Relocation of Office & Research Development
and the Tucson Program Office)

RES. NO. 192-90

- 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has been advised by the
2 Director of Indian Health Service (IHS) that the Research
3 and Development (R & D) section and the Training Branch
4 of the Office of Health Program Research and Development
5 (OHPRD) will be moved to Albuquerque, New Mexico to staff
6 a Technical Support Center; and
- 7 WHEREAS, it is further proposed that the Tucson Program Office
8 (TPO) will be moved under the administration of the
9 Phoenix Area; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has had a long standing
11 relationship with the Indian Health Service in the
12 provision of research and development with cooperation
13 of the Nation; and
- 14 WHEREAS, no formal notification has been received of any plans to
15 move the Tucson Program Office under the administration
16 of the Phoenix Area; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the impact, loss of positions, transfer of positions and
18 program administration continuity is not known; and
- 19 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tohono O'Odham Nation to
20 participate, as an equal partner with the Pasqua Yaqui
21 Tribe and the Indian Health Service in a task force to
22 assess, analyze, review and develop a plan to address the
23 proposed move of the Tucson Program Office under the
24 administration of the Phoenix Area Office.
- 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
26 Council does hereby appoint Joanne C. Preston of the
27 Health & Human Services Committee; Willard Anita, Health
28 Task Force Member; Andrew Lorentine, Acting Health
29 Director and Richard Ramirez, Chairman's Designee to
30 serve as the core team to represent the Nation in the
31 assessment, analysis, review and development of a plan
32 to address and assure that the best interest of the

1 Nation are considered and protected in the proposed move
2 to the Phoenix Area.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the core team is authorized to call
4 upon and utilize other staff and agencies in the
5 assessment, analysis, review and development of the plan.


6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation requests the
7 Indian Health Service to provide funding support to meet
8 the expenses in the development of the plan. Expenses
9 that are to include: mileage, duplication, consulting
10 fees, supplies and travel expenses.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Research and Development
12 and the Tucson Program Office continue to be maintained
13 and funded at its current level to include maintenance
14 of all positions, until such time as the Tohono O'Odham
15 Nation and the Pasqua Yaqui Tribe, by resolution, agree
16 to the move.


17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the core team provide monthly updates
18 to the Legislative Council and that any plan developed
19 by the core team shall be presented to the Tohono O'Odham
20 Legislative Council for final approval.

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
22 on the 6th. day of June, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
23 present with a vote of 1,384.5 for; 339.5 against; -0- not
24 voting; 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
25 by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
26 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
27 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
28 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
29 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




