RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Extending the Water Recharge Study authorized under Res. No. 35-90)

RES. NO. 197-90

- WHEREAS, Res. No. 35-90, "Authorization of a Water Recharge Investigation on the San Xavier District Utilizing CAP Waters," requested the Water Resources Committee to perform the following four tasks:
 - (1) Explore the technical feasibility of a recharge program, either alone or in concert with the City of Tucson, in lieu of allocating those waters for delivery to the 9B new farm.
 - (2) Identify new provisions of law needed in Congress, in the Legislative Council, and in the Arizona Legislature to implement a water recharge program, consistent with principles, benefits, and obligations of the 1982 Settlement Act.
 - (3) Request the assistance of the Bureau of Reclamation and other interested parties to undertake a thorough assessment of a recharge program, while insuring that the federal obligation to construct a new water project at the San Xavier District is not waived.
 - (4) Recommend actions to the Legislative Council needed to implement a recharge program for the San Xavier District using 9B water, if such a program proves desirable; and
- whereas, technical and legal studies completed by the consultants to date indicate that a physical recharge of water teamed with supplemental congressional legislation and a water planning effort could achieve the goals of the Nation, District, and allottees; and
- WHEREAS, additional time is needed to refine the various components and to develop final recommendations pursuant to a water recharge study, and
- WHEREAS, timely action is needed because of the following:
 - (1) Any Supplemental legislation needed to implement a recharge program will need to be introduced to Congress by early July.
 - (2) A congressional proposal by the Bureau of Reclamation is already pending to delay its SAWRSA obligation relative to new water development at San Xavier with no benefits to the Nation in exchange for the delay.
- WHEREAS, to make an informed and effective decision, the Legislative Council needs to receive final recommendations by the end of June, 1990.

No. 35-90, shall be 3 extended until June 30, 1990 to pursue the following 4 tasks: 5 (1) Refine the technical component of the recharge study 6 to identify the most feasible recharge options and their associated costs. 7 Continue discussions with off-reservation parties to (2) 8 refine provisions of a proposed congressional supplement to SAWRSA needed to pursue a recharge 9 program. 10 Initiate discussions with allottee representatives (3) to explore ways to accommodate the needs of allottees 11 under a recharge program. 12 FURTHER RESOLVED that interest from the Trust Fund 13 established pursuant to the 1982 Settlement Act to be used 14 to pursue this analysis, pursuant to an approved budget 15 by the Budget and Finance Committee, and the Tohono 16 O'odham Legislative Council. 17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Water Resources Committee shall 18 present final recommendations pursuant to a water recharge 19 program at a special Legislative Council session on July 20 5, 1990. 21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th day of June, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was 22 present with a vote of 1,029.5 for; 493.5 against; 201 voting; 0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by 23 Section 1 (a), (c), & (i)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant 25 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 26 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 27 28 Edward D.
