LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 205-90

1 WHEREAS, on July 5, 1990, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
2 held a Special Council Meeting pursuant to Resolution No.
3 197-90, "Extending the Water Recharge Study authorized
4 under 35-90"; and


5 WHEREAS, the purpose of this meeting was to review the final
6 recommendations of the Water Resources Committee regarding
7 a water recharge program utilizing CAP water for the San
8 Xavier District; and

9 WHEREAS, two recommendations came forth, one was to have the Water
10 Resources Committee Consultant, Elizabeth Checchio, report
11 on her work and the other was to provide copies to the
12 Council of a memo dated July 5, 1990 from the Water
13 Resources Committee Chairman to the Legislative Council
14 Chairman discussing the water recharge study.


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
16 Council that it hereby approves the two recommendations.

21 Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
22 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
23 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
24 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
25 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
