2 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did place the following items on
3 the agenda for the July 5, 1990 Special Meeting; Title XX-
4 Daycare FY-91 Budget, Hia'ced O'odham FY-90 Budget, and
5 O'odham in Mexico FY-90 Budget; and

6 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee recommended that the
7 Nation provide funding for the Title XX-Daycare until the
8 budget has been negotiated and awarded in order to avoid
9 any interruption of the program's operations; the
10 committee further recommended that supplemental funds
11 equal to 16% of the total Salaries be provided from the
12 Nation's general fund to enable the program to comply with
13 the Nation's adjusted Fringe Benefit rate of 28%; and

14 WHEREAS, the committee's recommendation to have the Nation provide
15 funding for the Title XX-Daycare conflicts with the
16 Nation's general policy; and

17 WHEREAS, the issue of reimbursement from the funding agency was
18 questionable and unconfirmed; and

19 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee recommended that the
20 budgets of the Hia'ced O'odham and the O'odham in Mexico
21 be tabled until the July General Session to allow for
22 committee review; and

23 WHEREAS, funding authorization for both programs expired June 30,
24 1990, necessitating authorization to continue operations.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
26 Council that the agenda items of; Title XX-Daycare,
27 Hia'ced O'odham Budget, and the O'odham in Mexico Budget
28 are hereby tabled until the July General Session.

29 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Budget and Finance Committee shall
30 prepare appropriate Legislation reflecting their
31 recommendations with respects to Title XX-Daycare for
32 consideration by the Legislative Council and that the




