

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Rules Committee to draft a Resolution requesting the
Resignation of the Nation's Chairman)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 210-90

1 WHEREAS, on June 8, 1990, the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation, Angelo Joaquin, Sr. personally addressed the
3 Legislative Council regarding his future plans; and

4 WHEREAS, Chairman Joaquin read a statement which discussed the
5 possibility of a medical retirement; and

6 WHEREAS, on June 8, 1990, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
7 agreed to relay the information provided by the Chairman
8 to the District Councils; and

9 WHEREAS, on July 9, 1990, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
10 again discussed the statement including the respective
11 District Councils' views on the matter; and

12 WHEREAS, several Districts' enacted resolutions requesting for the
13 resignation of the Nation's Chairman.

14 WHEREAS, a motion was made to request for the resignation of the
15 Nation's Chairman, but was withdrawn following a request
16 for a written draft of the motion.


17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
18 Council that it hereby orders the Legislative Rules
19 Committee to draft a resolution requesting for the
20 resignation of the Nation's Chairman.

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that said draft resolution will incorporate
22 the positions received from several of the Nation's
23 District Councils.


24 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that this draft resolution be returned to the
25 General Council for consideration on July 10, 1990.

26 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on
27 the 9th day of July, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
28 present with a vote of 897.5 for; 552.0 against; 274.5 not voting;
29 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
30 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
31 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
32 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
