

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Recognizing SCF's Youth Delegation of the Nation
as "Cultural Emissaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation")

RES. NO. 216-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation promotes and fosters the
2 development of leadership skills and the development of
3 positive self-esteem of its youth by means of
4 participation in cross-cultural activities; and

5 WHEREAS, the Save the Children Federation, a non-profit,
6 international organization, has been instrumental in
7 providing unique opportunities for the Nation and its
8 youth to attain the above-mentioned objectives; and

9 WHEREAS, through the efforts of the Save the Children Federation,
10 the Choctaw Nation of Mississippi and the Tohono O'odham
11 Nation activities have been initiated for a cross-cultural
12 exchange that will enable the young members of both
13 Nations to experience cultural-awareness, which will serve
14 as a cornerstone for the development of leadership
15 qualities desired by both Nations; and

16 WHEREAS, in accepting the invitation extended by the Choctaw
17 Nation, a delegation of Tohono O'odham members will be
18 traveling to Philadelphia, Mississippi to participate in
19 the Summer Youth Cultural Exchange; and

20 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation takes pride in acknowledging the
21 participation of its youth, along with their Chaperones
22 and Drivers, in the Summer Youth Cultural Exchange in


6 WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Nation, Angelo Joaquin, Sr., did on
7 July 2, 1990 issue a Proclamation acknowledging the Save
8 the Children Federation's Youth Delegation of the Tohono
9 O'odham Nation as the official "Cultural Emissaries of the
10 Tohono O'odham Nation;" and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislature concurs with the action of
12 the Chairman of the Nation and do hereby acknowledge the
13 Save the Children Federation's Youth Delegation of the
14 Tohono O'odham Nation as the official "Cultural Emissaries
15 of the Tohono O'odham Nation."

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
17 Council that it hereby concurs with the Nation's Chairman,
18 Angelo J. Joaquin, Sr., in proclaiming and acknowledging
19 the Save the Children Federation's Youth Delegation of the
20 Tohono O'odham Nation as the official "Cultural Emissaries
21 of the Tohono O'odham Nation" while attending the Summer
22 Youth Cultural Exchange in Philadelphia, Mississippi.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
24 on the 9th day of July, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
25 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
26 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
27 by Section 1 (c)(8) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
28 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
29 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
30 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
31 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
