

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham FY 1991 Credit and Finance Contract Extension)

RES. NO. 229-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Credit and Finance Program under an FY 1990 P. L. 93-638
3 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
4 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Part 271.2 requires that all proposals to
5 recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono
6 O'odham Legislative Council for approval at least 120 days
7 prior to the contract termination; and
8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to contract for
9 provisions of services during FY 1991; and
10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
11 approved the Credit and Finance Program recontract.
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
13 Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of
14 Indian Affairs to contract with the Tohono O'odham Nation
15 under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the
16 provision of services titled: Credit and Finance.
17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract extension
18 will commence on October 01, 1990 through ~~September 30,~~
19 1991.
20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
21 that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
22 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
23 being conducted and no executed contract extension has
24 been approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
26 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
27 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
28 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
29 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
30 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
31 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
2 on the 10th day of July, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
3 present with a vote of 1,504.0 for; 106.0 against; 114.0 not
4 voting; 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
5 by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
7 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
8 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
9 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
