

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'odham FY 1991 Behavioral Health Services - Alcoholism/  
Rehabilitation and After Care Program for Adolescents Components)

RES. NO. 238-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the  
2 Behavioral Health Services - Alcoholism and Rehabilitation  
3 and After Care for Adolescents Program Components P. L.  
4 99-570 program components extensions of the FY 1990 P. L.  
5 93-638 contracts with the Public Health, Indian Health  
6 Services; and

7 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial  
8 to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to extend the  
10 contract for provisions of services during FY 1991; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and  
12 approved the Behavioral Health Services Program -  
13 Alcoholism and Rehabilitation and Aftercare for  
14 Adolescents, P. L. 99-570 program components FY 1991  
15 contract extension and budget.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
17 Council does authorize and request the Indian Health  
18 Service to extend Contract No. 249-89-0009 with the Tohono  
19 O'odham Nation under P. L. 93-638.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract extension  
21 will commence on October 01, 1990 through September 30,  
22 1991.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
24 that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate  
25 the program in the interim while negotiations are still  
26 being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded  
27 by the Indian Health Service.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
29 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
30 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are  
31 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,  
32 provided however, that any amendments affecting the

1 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be  
2 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
4 on the 11th day of July, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
5 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;  
6 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  
7 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,  
and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
