L. 93-638 contracts with the Public Health, Indian Health Services; and WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to extend the contract for provisions of services during FY 1991; and WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the Behavioral Health Services Program -Alcoholism and Rehabilitation and Aftercare for Adolescents, P. L. 99-570 program components FY 1991 contract extension and budget. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize and request the Indian Health Service to extend Contract No. 249-89-0009 with the Tohono O'odham Nation under P. L. 93-638. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract extension will commence on October 01, 1990 through September 30, 1991. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by the Indian Health Service. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
