

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham FY 1991 WIC Program)

RES. NO. 239-90

- 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided preventive health
2 care for women, infants and children during Fiscal Year
3 1990; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from
5 the United States Department of Agriculture for programs
6 designed to benefit women, infants and children; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has contracted with the Inter-
8 Tribal Council of Arizona for funds to operate and fund
9 its Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients has been
11 beneficial, and services continue to be necessary to help
12 alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health
13 of individuals at risk.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
15 Council that it hereby approves the application for
16 funding from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to
17 continue to operate and provide services to eligible
18 women, infants and children.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract will commence
20 on October 01, 1990 through September 30, 1991 unless
21 extended by mutual agreement by both parties.
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
23 that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
24 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
25 being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded
26 by the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona.
- 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
28 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
29 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
30 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
31 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
32 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
2 on the 11th day of July, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
3 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
4 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
5 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
7 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
8 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
9 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
