

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Judicial to Continue Operations - Tabling Action  
on Funding Request for further Information)

RES. NO. 241-90

1 WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch operates a portion of its adminis-  
2 tration under a "638" contract at a base level consistent  
3 with the approved levels of Congress; and

4 WHEREAS, the BIA has failed to provide funds at the approved levels  
5 and has maintained a position contrary to the intentions  
6 of Congress; and

7 WHEREAS, this dilemma has resulted in the exhaustion of all  
8 available operating funds of the Judicial Branch as of  
9 June 30, 1990; and,

10 WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch has submitted a request for additional  
11 funds from the Nation; and,

12 WHEREAS, it would benefit the Legislative Council to review an  
13 analysis of all funds received and expended, further, it  
14 is necessary to review the legislative history of the  
15 Judicial Branch's contract funding.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
17 Council that the Judicial Branch continue its  
18 operations until such time that the Legislature has  
19 reviewed the legislative history of the Branch's  
20 contract funding, and reviewed the funding analysis,  
21 and has taken affirmative action on the request for  
22 additional funding.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
24 on the 11th day of July, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
25 present with a vote of 1,452.0 for; 272.0 against; -0- not voting;  
26 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  
27 1(d) (2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
28 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
29 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
30 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
31 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
