(San Xavier District FY 1990 Third Quarter Budget Amendment)

1 WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the San Xavier District to
2 provide additional funds to better serve its constituency;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the current budget of \$514,286.00
5 by \$45,000.00 to cover additional expenses and/or cost as
6 outlined in the attached budget & justification; and

7 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District did by Resolution #SXDC 06-90-06
8 approve to increase its current budget from \$514,286.00
9 to \$559,286.00; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approves of
11 same.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
13 Council does hereby increase the San Xavier District FY
14 '90 budget by \$45,000.00, increasing the total to
15 \$559,286.00 for fiscal year 1990.

17 on the 12th. day of July, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
18 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
19 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
20 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
22 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
23 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


