9 category is hereby tabled.


10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and other appropriate

15 of this Council's determination in accordance with Section
16 4 of Article III of the Enrollment Ordinance; and place the
17 names of each applicant upon the membership roll of the
18 Tohono O'Odham Nation in accordance with Article V of the
19 Enrollment Ordinance.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council
21 on the 5th day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
22 was present with a vote of 1,607.5 for; -0- against; 116.5 not
23 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
24 by Section 1 of Article II and of Section 1 (h) of Article VI of
the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986 and approved by the
Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
March 6, 1986 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984).


