

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Approve the Date of August 16, 1990 for a Special Council  
Meeting Regarding Water Issues)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 257-90

1 WHEREAS, on August 6, 1990, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
2 considered a request from the Water Resources Committee  
3 for a Special Council Meeting on Thursday, August 16,  
4 1990; and

5 WHEREAS, a tentative agenda formulated by the Nation's Attorney  
6 General, with the input of other legal advisors, was  
7 reviewed and minor changes were recommended; and

8 WHEREAS, the purpose of the Special Meeting was to discuss legal  
9 issues, claims, and strategies concerning the allottees'  
10 water rights within the Southern Arizona Water Rights  
11 Settlement Act; and

12 WHEREAS, for the best interests of the Nation, the Attorney General  
13 recommended that the meeting be held in a closed session,  
14 open only to the Legislative Council, the allottees, and  
15 other tribal officials.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
17 Council that it hereby approves the date of Thursday,  
18 August 16, 1990 for a Special Council Meeting.


19 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the tentative agenda is hereby approved,  
20 with the recommended changes.

21 The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the  
22 6th day of August, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present  
23 with a vote of 1,372.5 for; -0- against; 351.5 not voting; 03  
24 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  
25 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,  
and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
