its FY '89-90 Budget; and


2 WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District FY 89-90 was \$174,894.76 and will  
3 be amended by \$9,705.02 totaling for the new budget of  
4 \$184,599.98; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed the  
6 proposed budget amendment and approves of same.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
8 Council that it hereby approves the Gu Achi District  
9 Council budget amendment to be expended in accordance  
10 with the attached budget.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
12 on the 5th day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
13 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;  
14 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  
15 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,  
and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




