

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of Antone Family's Request for Assistance)


RES. NO. 270-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did hear and  
2 receive a request for monetary assistance from the Antone  
3 family on May 11, 1990 for a heart and lung transplant for  
4 their mother; and  
5 WHEREAS, the patient, Joann Garcia, who is the mother of the Antone  
6 family is an enrolled member of the Tohono O'odham Nation;  
7 and  
8 WHEREAS, the health problem confronting the Antone family is above  
9 and beyond their financial capability; and  
10 WHEREAS, the Sells Service Unit of the Indian Health Service  
11 professes to have no funds for the required medical  
12 treatment; and  
13 WHEREAS, the first step in such a transplant procedure is a Cardiac  
14 Catheterization to determine the suitability of the  
15 patient as a candidate for such a procedure; and  
16 WHEREAS, the estimated cost of a Cardiac Catheterization is  
17 approximately \$5,000; and  
18 WHEREAS, some months have passed since the Legislative Council  
19 referred this matter to the Executive, Budget & Finance,  
20 and Health & Human Services Committees and there has been  
21 no action to address this family's critical need; and  
22 WHEREAS, the Health & Human Services Committee is hereby  
23 recommending that the Nation fund the preliminary surgical  
24 procedures, of approximately \$5,000, and that a separate  
25 account be established, monitored, and maintained by the  
26 Nation's Chief Financial Officer (CFO) for this special  
27 activity.  
28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
29 Council that it hereby adopts the recommendations of the  
30 Health & Human Services Committee to establish funding for  
31 preliminary surgical procedures to determine if Joann  
32 Garcia would be a suitable candidate for transplant  
operations.


1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a separate account be established,  
 2 monitored, and maintained by the Nation's Chief Financial  
 3 Officer (CFO) for this purpose with periodic reporting to  
 4 the appropriate committees and the Legislative Council.

5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
 6 on the 8th day of August, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
 7 present with a vote of 1,114.0 for; 229.0 against; 381.0 not  
 8 voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
 9 by Section 1 (c)(2), (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


