

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'odham FY 1991 Head Start Program Grant)

RES. NO. 278-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has recognized the importance  
2 of Head Start Education and stimulation; and

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated a Head Start  
4 Program to provide and serve educational and pre-school  
5 learning experiences for children between the ages of 3-  
6 5 years; and

7 WHEREAS, the Department of Health & Human Services, Administration  
8 for Children, Youth & Families has provided funding for  
9 the operation of the Head Start Program; and

10 WHEREAS, the Administration for Children, Youth and Families will  
11 provide funds for the continued operation of the Head  
12 Start Program to eligible and qualifying applicants; and

13 WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has prepared a proposal for FY 1991  
14 program operations to be submitted to the Department of  
15 Health & Human Services; and

16 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and  
17 approved the Head Start grant.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
19 Council that it does authorize and request the Department  
20 of Health & Human Services to contract with the Tohono  
21 O'Odham Nation for the provision of services titled: Head  
22 Start Program.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant will be from  
24 November 01, 1990 through October 31, 1991.


25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
26 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
27 the program from which grants are requested herewith which  
28 have not been negotiated and executed by the Department  
29 of Health & Human Services prior to the start of the  
30 funding year.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
32 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the


Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th. day of August, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,667.0 for; -0- against; 57.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


