

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Rescinding Legislative Order No. 18-90)


LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 32-90

1 WHEREAS, on February 5, 1990, the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2 Council approved the assessment of a \$25 fine to all
3 Council Members not present for Roll Call pursuant to
4 Article II, Section 3.A.1 of the Legislative Rules; and
5 WHEREAS, Article II, Section 3.A.1 provides, "For excessive
6 temporary absenteeism or tardiness a person shall, by
7 formal legislative action, be assessed a fine of \$25.00
8 to be withheld from their per diem payment or salary";
9 and
10 WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules do not define the terms "excessive
11 temporary absenteeism" or "excessive tardiness"; and
12 WHEREAS, other undefined terms may exist in the Legislative Rules;
13 and
14 WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the Council if the
15 undefined terms of "excessive temporary absenteeism" and
16 "excessive tardiness" be defined before the assessment of
17 any fines upon individual Council Members.
18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
19 Council that it hereby rescinds Legislative Order No.
20 18-90, "Members not Present for Roll Call to be Fined."
21 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
22 that it refers the undefined terms of "excessive temporary
23 absenteeism" and "excessive tardiness" to the Legislative
24 Rules Committee for definition and clarification.
25 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Rules Committee is hereby authorized
26 to define other terms which require clarification in order
27 to effectively enforce the Legislative Rules.
28 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on
29 the 6th day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was
30 present with a vote of 1,129.5 for; 335.0 against; 259.5 not
31 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
32 by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
