

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Intergovernmental Agreement between the
State of Arizona and the Tribal Employment Rights Office)

RES. NO. 338-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tribal Employment Rights Office has recognized the low
2 percentage of Native American employment under the state
3 government; and

4 WHEREAS, the members of the Southwest Tribal Employment Rights
5 Organization (SWTERO) within the State of Arizona have
6 also recognized the need to increase the employment of
7 Native Americans within the state government; and

8 WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Affirmative Action has been
9 advised of the low utilization of Native American
10 employment under state government; and

11 WHEREAS, it is the intention of the SWTEROs to coordinate a
12 campaign to recruit and employ more Native Americans under
13 state government; and

14 WHEREAS, the State Department of Personnel has recognized the needs
15 of the TEROs and has agreed to provide each individual
16 TERO office training in processing state applications
17 through an Intergovernmental Agreement; and

18 WHEREAS, the local TERO office has reviewed and are prepared to
19 enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State
20 Department of Personnel; and

21 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission is
22 now requesting approval to enter into an Intergovernmental
23 Agreement with the State of Arizona Personnel Department.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it
25 hereby grants approval for the TERO office to enter into
26 an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Arizona
27 Personnel Department.

28 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
29 on the 18th. day of September, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
30 was present with a vote of 1,598.0 for; 63.5 against; 62.5 not
31 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
32 by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
