

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Continuing Budget Resolution for Fiscal Year 1991)

DEFEATED
RES. NO. 342-90

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council must authorize
2 budgets for expenditure of funds in Fiscal Year 1991 by
3 programs and committees funded by the Tribal Budget; and
4 WHEREAS, a full review of the activities and budget requests of
5 those budget entities have not been completed.


6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
7 Council that:

- 8 (1) A continuing budget for 1991 is authorized in an
9 amount equal to two months of the 1990 Tribal Budget.
10 (2) The total amount authorized is equal to \$855,340.
11 It shall be distributed to the expense accounts of
12 each of the budget entities according to the
13 distribution of the 1990 Tribal Budget as of August
14 31, 1990.
15 (3) This Continuing Budget Resolution shall be for the
16 period of time, from October 1, 1990 through November
17 30, 1990, inclusive.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation's Executive Branch shall
19 complete the budgeting process and present a comprehensive
20 FY 1991 budget, in accordance with the Executive Branch's
21 Policies and Procedures, to the Legislative Council for
22 review and action prior to the expiration of this
23 Continuing Budget Resolution.

24 The foregoing Resolution was DEFEATED by the Tohono O'odham Council
25 on the 19th day of September, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
26 was present with a vote of 411.5 for; 1,075.0 against; 237.5 not
27 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
28 by Section 1(d) (2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
29 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
30 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
31 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
32 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
