

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Refer Draft Resolution regarding Recharge Investigation to the  
Water Resources Committee)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 34-90

1 WHEREAS, on February 8, 1990 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
2 were presented a report from the San Xavier District  
3 regarding water concerns; and

4 WHEREAS, such report included a proposal to investigate a recharge  
5 and riparian rehabilitation project utilizing C.A.P.  
6 water; and

7 WHEREAS, a draft resolution was presented and reviewed authorizing  
8 funds from the Water Trust fund to be used to conduct such  
9 an investigation; and

10 WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the Nation that such  
11 authorization be reviewed by the Legislative Water  
12 Resources Committee.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
14 Council that it hereby tables action on the draft  
15 resolution titled, "Authorization of a Water Recharge  
16 Investigation on the San Xavier District Utilizing C.A.P.  
17 Waters" and refers this draft to the Legislative Water  
18 Resources Committee for review.

19 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Legislative Water Resources  
20 Committee is hereby authorized to confer with the  
21 Executive Office and the San Xavier District officials  
22 regarding this draft resolution.

23 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the draft resolution be returned to the  
24 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for reconsideration  
25 prior to the end of this General Session.

26 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on  
27 the 8th day of February, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
28 present with a vote of 1,603.5 for; 120.5 against; -0- not voting;  
29 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  
30 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
31 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,  
32 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


