

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Solid Waste Program FY '91 Budget in the Amount of
\$72,212 and Employee Benefits in the Amount of \$11,339)

- 1 WHEREAS, the current 1990 fiscal year for the Solid Waste Program
2 culminates at midnight, September 30, 1990; and
3 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the continued administration of the
4 Solid Waste Program to adopt an operation budget prior to
5 the inception of the new fiscal year; and
6 WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Program of the Nation has conducted a
7 detailed, comprehensive review and analysis of the fiscal
8 needs of its office for FY-91; and
9 WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Program has prepared and presented a
10 budget for its FY-91 operations; and
11 WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Program budget is consistent to a uniform
12 format concurred to by the Legislative, Executive, and
13 Judicial Branches; and
14 WHEREAS, the approved format transfers cost for Capital
15 Expenditures, Employee Benefits and Major Repairs/
16 Renovations to separate consolidated accounts, to be
17 administered by the Executive Branch on behalf of the
18 Nation as a whole; and
19 WHEREAS, the Legislature approves of the Solid Waste Program FY'91
20 budget as submitted.
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
22 Council that it hereby approves the Solid Waste Program
23 FY'91 budget in the amount of \$72,212 .
24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all costs for Capital Equipment,
25 Employee Benefits in the amount of \$11,339.00, and Major
26 Repairs/Renovations be transferred to separate
27 consolidated accounts, to be administered by the Executive
28 Branch on behalf of the Nation as a whole.
29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
30 on the 26th. day of September, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
31 was present with a vote of 1,054.0 for; 378.0 against; 292.0 not
32 voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
by Section 1 (d)(2)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
