National Congress of American Indians (NCAI))

RES. NO. 377-90

1 WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) will hold
2 its Annual NCAI Convention in Albuquerque, New Mexico on
3 November 11-16, 1990; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has in the past and is currently
5 a member of NCAI; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has determined to continue to
7 remain a member of NCAI; and


8 WHEREAS, annual membership dues are due and payable at the annual
9 convention of each year for the following year.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
11 Council does hereby authorize payment of the NCAI
12 membership dues, as specified in the NCAI By-Laws.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the all Legislative Council Members be
14 given the opportunity to attend the 1990 Annual NCAI
15 Convention.


16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
17 on the 16th. day of October, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
18 was present with a vote of 1,607.5 for; -0- against; 116.5 not
19 voting; 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
20 by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


