

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Job Opportunities Basic Skills Title II FY 1991 Budget)

RES. NO. 386-90

1 WHEREAS, Public Law 100-485, the Family Support Act of 1988, was
2 enacted into law on October 13, 1988 to revise the AFDC
3 Program to emphasize work, child support, and family
4 benefits, to amend Title IV of the Social Security Act,
5 to encourage and assist needy children and parents under
6 the new program to obtain the education, training and
7 employment needed to avoid long term welfare dependence;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the Family Support Act of 1988 creates a new AFDC
10 education, training and employment program, known as Job
11 Opportunities and Basic Skills Training (JOBS) Program;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, included in the Family Support Act is a provision which
14 allows the Tohono O'odham Nation to request from the
15 Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) for direct
16 funding to conduct a JOBS Program; and

17 WHEREAS, on September 20, 1990, JOBS Information Memorandum #JOBS-
18 FSA-IM-90-4 provided the Tohono O'odham Nation with an
19 estimated allocation in the amount of \$99,189 with the
20 understanding that the final allocation amount will be
21 issued in January 1991; and


22 WHEREAS, the JOBS Title II Program has submitted for review a six
23 (6) month budget in the amount of \$99,189 for the period
24 October 01, 1990 through March 31, 1991, with the
25 understanding that the final budget shall be submitted for
26 approval after receipt of the final allocation figures
27 from DHHS.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
29 Council that it hereby approves the Job Opportunities
30 Basic Skills Training (JOBS) Program budget for six (6)
31 months in the amount of \$99,189 for the period of October
32 01, 1990 through March 31, 1990.


1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
2 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
3 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
4 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
5 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
6 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted
7 for further prior approval by this Council.

8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
9 on the 18th. day of October, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum
10 was present with a vote of 1,411.5 for; 63.5 against; 249.0 not
11 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
12 by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
